## When was the queen born?

• Elizabeth II was born on April 21, 1926 in London. She was the first child of Queen Elizabeth and King George VI.



### Queen's interests

#### Father takes the throne

• When Elizabeth was 10 years old, her grandfather, King George V, died in 1936. Her uncle, Prince of Wales Edward VIII, assumed the throne but abdicated on December 11, 1936. Her father, George VI, became the next king, and Elizabeth took first place in the line of succession to the British throne.





## Royal wedding ceremony!!!

• Elizabeth II met Philip, son of Prince Andrzej Grecki, and Alicja Battenberg. In 1946, Philip, despite the opposition of the British aristocracy, received permission from King George VI to marry his daughter. On July 9, 1947, the engagement of Elizabeth and Philip was officially announced. The wedding took place on November 20, 1947 at Westminster Abbey.

### Ascension to the Throne

• Elizabeth II ascended the throne at the age of 25 after the death of her father George VI on February 6, 1952, and was proclaimed queen shortly thereafter. The ceremony took place in the Palace of St. James. After she became the Queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland at coronation





## The death of the Queen

• Death and funeral ceremony of Queen Elizabeth II of the Windsor Dynasty. Elizabeth II, Queen of Great Britain and other Commonwealth kingdoms, one of Britain's longest-lived and longest-reigning monarchs, died on September 8, 2022 at the age of 96 at Balmoral Castle in Scotland.
